The Golfing Experience

With a championship 18 hole course renowned for its challenging layout and the hidden jewel of our 9 hole course, the Lake Karrinyup Country Club is widely acknowledged as Western Australia's premier private golf club and was in 2010 rated by the Golf Digest as "Australia's Number 12 Ranked Course" .



Lake Karrinyup was founded in 1928 with a course layout designed by Alex Russell (1924 open champion of Australia), the business partner of legendary golf architect Dr Alistair MacKenzie (designer of the US Masters Championship course at Augusta, Georgia). The Lake Karrinyup Country Club of today is one which constantly upgrades its demanding world class golf course and fine clubhouse facilities. The course was home to the Johnnie Walker Classic in 2002 and for the first time in the history of this prestigious international event

it remained in the same location for two successive years.

The lush undulating Couch fairways and manicured Bent grass greens are set around a large natural lake and amongst a forest of magnificent native trees and plants. Over 75 species of birds have been identified in the wetlands surrounding the large natural lake while kangaroos abound amid flowering large eucalyptus trees and colourful shrubs. Surprisingly, this natural bushland course, which gives no hint of surrounding and sought-after urban development, is less than 15 minutes from the capital city of Perth and close to the famous white beaches of the west coast.



It is an island of tranquillity and natural charm well hidden from any sign of the busy bustling landscape around it. Simply put, it is a wonderful place to play the great game of golf.

Clubhouse

Dining Room

The ideal choice for large Club dining and entertainment events, as well as large private functions, the Dining Room overlooks the 18th green, with ghost gums accentuated by lights to add ambience to your evenings. The capacity is 180 seated with the dance floor or 300 for a stand up cocktail function, with the huge parquet dance floor uncovered as needed. This room is decorated to suit Club events or your own special occasions.

MacKenzie Russell Room

This newly re-fitted room provides an exclusive fine dining private room for members and their guests and is available for business lunches and small conferences. With an exclusive menu and silver service for the MacKenzie Russell Room, it is a perfect alternative for your next dinner party.

Bistro

Recently renovated in Retro style and boasting a relaxing view of our beautiful pool and bbq areas, the Bistro is a favourite spot for family dining, with good quality food and reasonable prices.

BBQ/Poolside

This area can be exclusively booked for your family, private or corporate function where our own chef will happily cook your barbecue if you wish or you may be the master chef! Please note members may not ordinarily bring their own food for cooking on the barbecue.

Bar

Available for à la carte dining during the week for lunch or dinner, the Bar is where pre and post golf meals are served, golf presentations are held and is a popular meeting place for members to linger over cheese and nibbles, and perhaps even enjoy a bottle of wine from our exclusive reserve cellar.

The Terrace

Great during summer months with a popular 'lunch on the terrace' which is suitable to entertain corporate clients or spoil yourself with a lovely lunch in the sun with friends.

Other Facilities

Tennis Courts

Two beautiful grass courts are available to book by phoning the office. There is no charge for members, with a small guest fee payable. The courts are closed for a few months over winter for rejuvenation.

Pro Shop

The Club Professional, Graham Warburton is a AAA member of the Australian PGA (since 1975), and has over 30 years of experience in golf tuition. Equipment for hire includes golf clubs (full set, ladies and gents, left and right hand), electric buggies and motorised carts. Facilities are available for the storage of golf equipment (bag and clubs only). Open 7 days a week, the Pro Shop sells a wide range of golf equipment, golf attire and accessories, as well as offering a full, on-site repair facility. Graham and his assisting teaching staff offer a wide range of tuition services including individual tuition, group tuition/clinics, video analysis (using Dartfish system) and playing lessons, plus the offer of a complementary group lesson for newly elected members at the Club.

Locker Rooms & Showers

Ladies and gentlemen have access to well-equipped shower facilities and, for the full playing members, lockers are allocated at no extra charge. There may be a waiting list for men, as demand outweighs supply, however the Pro Shop have keys to Day Lockers for those who would like to avail themselves of one.

FEES & CHARGES

- ☑ One off Entrance Fee of **\$4,125** (under 30, 50%). A 25% discount applies for family members.
- ☑ Minimum spend on **House Account** of \$165 per quarter
- ☑ Entrance fee of \$500 for **Junior** (18-20 year olds) with no house appropriation levy. Annual subscription \$850.
- ☑ **Temporary** - see separate application form

Club Policy requires prospective new members to direct their enquiry through a current member. Contact the office on 9422 8222 for information on being a Proposer (including obligations) and to obtain the necessary paperwork.



If you are keen to become a member but are not yet acquainted with the required number of LKCC members to join, the Club has made provision for temporary (introductory) membership for Ladies. This is subject to Committee approval and will be offered if the candidate has some golfing experience; preferably with an official handicap and a knowledge of the rules and etiquette of golf. The category of membership is Provisional Playing Associate and is valid for a maximum of two years. If you wish to continue after this time, it would be necessary to apply for membership in the normal manner, ie Proposer, Secunder and five Referees.

Temporary membership attracts a 25% loading on subscriptions.

In 2012, this is \$3,175 at age 30+

FURTHER INFORMATION ON NINE HOLE MEMBERSHIP

(not available as a temporary category)

For lady members who would like to play nine holes on either the championship or short course.

- ◆ Nine Hole Associate Membership entitles the member to play 9 holes ONLY on the main or short course on any day except Wednesday or Saturday, (with the exception of points 3 and 4 below) with the opportunity to join in female or medley nine hole competitions as shown in the fixture book.
- ◆ A Nine Hole Associate Member may invite a guest to play 9 holes ONLY, paying the full green fee appropriate at that time.
- ◆ A Nine Hole Associate Member wishing to play 18 holes socially with a current member may do so by paying the member's guest green fee appropriate at that time.
- ◆ A Nine Hole Associate Member wishing to play in Twilight or 14 hole competitions may do so as a guest of a current member by paying the appropriate members' guest green fee and competition fee.
- ◆ A Nine Hole Associate Member is entitled to play as a guest of a member (as in points 3 and 4 above) a maximum of 6 times per annum in total.
- ◆ A Nine Hole Associate Member (being female) shall be entitled to Voting Rights (other than the right to vote on Special Resolutions or the right to elect the Officers of the Club and the Ordinary Members of the Committee) upon the expiration of 3 years from the date of her election as an Associate Nine Hole Member.
- ◆ A Nine Hole Associate Member shall be ineligible to hold office in the club.
- ◆ Associate Members may transfer into the Nine Hole Associate Member category and the relevant subscription will apply. Those transferring from 'Senior Special' will be subject to house trading minimum spend if not a member for more than 25 years.
- ◆ Associate Nine Hole Members may transfer to other Associate Playing Categories. Any difference in Nomination Fee is to be paid and the relevant subscription of the new category will apply.
- ◆ Subscription: \$1,260. Quarterly house appropriation of \$105. This will be waived if the member qualifies for a senior discount, being 25 years of membership and 65 years of age.

Transferability:

- ◆ A Provisional or Full Playing Associate member may transfer to 9 Hole or Short Course Associate membership on application to the General Committee. A 9 Hole or Short Course member may transfer to the Associates Provisional or Associates Full Playing categories, subject to vacancies, and by applying to the General Committee in writing with the difference in Entrance Fees between the categories payable.
